The Mayor requested this information, however I am sending to all for your awareness.

We are researching the pipe installation date. We have a time range but not a specific date. We will not know the extent of the damage until the roadway is opened, and the pipe and base examined.

Below is information I received from Director Davis:

The stormwater pipe is 24 inch Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP). It appears that the part of the pipe crossing under Riverside Drive was installed between 2004 and 2014. This conclusion is based upon research of the 2004 and 2014 Storm Water Master Plan updates. It should be noted that the life expectancy of RCP in Florida is 75 – 100 years or more.

Subject: Small sink hole on Riverside at Avenue A

All.

Public works was notified by a resident of a small sink hole on Riverside Drive at Avenue A. We placed a cone over the hole until we could investigate more thoroughly today. This morning Director Davis, PW crew and I looked at the hole and determined the depression is caused by our stormwater pipe running across Riverside. The job is larger that we can or should handle. Director Davis took some photos and sent them to Scott Glaubitz (BSE) to review. Scott immediately contracted Brewer Paving and Development to come investigate the sink hole. Brewer has done many stormwater construction projects for the Town over the years, most notably, Orange Street, Andrews Drive, Dogwood, Rosewood, and Cherry.

Brewer will bring out a large metal plate to cover the sink hole tomorrow morning @8am. The plate will allow traffic to move on Riverside until the repairs can be made. Brewer can start on Tuesday, April 1st. I will bring this emergency repair to the Special Meeting on Monday, March 31st since the construction amount will exceed my threshold of \$5,000.
