The difference between Option A and Option B can paid for by the following:

1. The Safer Grant Award is: \$444,039.75 This leaves a difference of \$33,209.25 to make the department budget whole.

The difference can be paid for using a portion (\$33,209.25) from long term capital of (\$100,000) or a portion from the sale of the fire trucks (\$125,000) or Contingency (\$60,000)

- 2. The Town can borrow the \$477,249.00 from reserves. This can be repaid over time or not. Repayment will be determined by the Commission.
- 3. The Town can use the sale of the fire trucks (\$125,000) plus (\$100,000) from LTC and(\$252,249) from reserves.
- 4. The Town can use the Contingency line Item in Dept. 19 of(\$60,000), sale of fire trucks of (\$125,000), (\$100,000) from LTC and (\$192,249) from reserves. For the purposes of budgeting, I have moved \$477,249 from the General Fund to offset the expense for the 6 fire fighters. If the Town receives the grant, then the difference between the grant will be paid for using scenarios 1-4.

Should the Town not win the Safer Grant, and the Town wishes to move forward with the 6 full time fire fighters, then the Town can propose a Special Fire Assessment. The documentation required to institue a Special Fire Tax takes several months to complete. The paper work could be completed during FY26 to allow for the implementation of the tax in FY2027.

YEAR 2 of Safer Grant

If the Town wins the Safer Grant, the Town will receive \$444,039.75 from FEMA toward the expense for the 6 paid fire fighters. The Town will need to make up the difference using a Special Fire Tax Assessment or one of the funding options mentioned in the first column. The amounts listed in the first column would need to be increased to allow for increases in cost, salaries, etc.

YEAR 3 of Safer Grant

If the Town wins the Safer Grant, the Town will receive \$207,218.55 from FEMA toward the expense for the 6 paid fire fighters. The Town will need to make up the difference using a Special Fire Tax Assessment or one of the funding options mentioned.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RATIFYING, CONFIRMING, AND CERTIFYING THE ANNUAL FIRE SERVICES NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE COUNTY FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND FORWARDING THE SAME TO THE TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE FOR COLLECTION IN THE SAME MANNER AS AD VALOREM TAXES ARE COLLECTED; AND ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF RATES FOR THE FIRE SERVICES NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IMPOSED AGAINST ALL IMPROVED REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE BENEFIT AREA OF BREVARD COUNTY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025.

WHEREAS, Brevard County Fire Rescue is the primary source of fire services for all of unincorporated Brevard County as well as the Town of Grant-Valkaria, the Town of Melbourne Village, the Town of Palm Shores, and the City of West Melbourne; and

WHEREAS, section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, grants the Board of County Commissioners (the "COUNTY") the power to utilize the Uniform Method for collecting special non-ad valorem assessments; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Services Special Assessment is currently codified at Section 98-46 through 98-59 of the Brevard County Code of Ordinances (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2025 the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2025-048, adjusting the Fire Services Special Assessment Rate within the benefit area by an increase of thirty-seven percent (37%) in Fiscal Year 2025-2026, followed by an annual rate increase equal to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) or three (3) percent, whichever is lower; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution No. 2025-048, the rate increase to the fire services non-ad valorem special assessment for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 will be thirty-seven percent (37%); and

WHEREAS, by September 15th of each year, the Board of County Commissioners shall review the rolls for conformity with the non-ad valorem special assessment rates and make any changes or additions as necessary to conform the rolls to the rates; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the review, the Board of County Commissioners or its designee shall ratify, confirm, and certify a non-ad valorem assessment roll to the Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, the annual Fire Service Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll has been prepared, a summary of which is attached and made a part of this Resolution by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners is satisfied that the annual Fire Service Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll has been prepared in conformity with the schedule of rates, assessments and charges for fire service operations adopted by the Board on May 20, 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners:

- The Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida, certifies, ratifies and confirms that the Fire Service Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll for County fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, is in conformity with the schedule of rates, assessments and charges for fire service operations adopted by the Board on May 20, 2025 and August 26, 2025.
- The Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida, hereby certifies, 2. ratifies and confirms such Fire Service Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll as certified on a compatible electronic medium to the Tax Collector. The Tax Collector shall collect such Fire Service Non-Ad Valorem Assessment in the same manner as ad valorem taxes are collected.
- A certified copy of this Resolution shall be delivered to the Tax Collector of 3. Brevard County, Florida.



This is to inform you that the Town of Melbourne Beach has not received your Campaign Treasurer Report 2023 G3 which covered the period October 21, 2023, through November 2, 2023, that was due on November 3, 2023.

Late reports are assessed a fine per Florida State Statute 106.07(8)(b):

Upon determining that a report is late, the filing officer shall immediately notify the candidate or chair of the political committee as to the failure to file a report by the designated due date and that a fine is being assessed for each late day. The fine is \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each special primary election, special election, primary election, and general election, the fine is \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For reports required under s. 106.141(8), the fine is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. Upon receipt of the report, the filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine which is due and shall notify the candidate or chair or registered agent of the political committee. The filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine due based upon the earliest of the following:

- 1. When the report is actually received by such officer.
- 2. When the report is postmarked.
- When the certificate of mailing is dated.
- 4. When the receipt from an established courier company is dated.
- 5. When the electronic receipt issued pursuant to s. <u>106.0705</u> or other electronic filing system authorized in this section is dated.

Such fine shall be paid to the filing officer within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due, unless appeal is made to the Florida Elections Commission pursuant to paragraph (c). Notice is deemed complete upon proof of delivery of written notice to the mailing or street address on record with the filing officer. In the case of a candidate, such fine is not an allowable campaign expenditure and shall be paid only from personal funds of the candidate. This is to inform you that on Thursday, November 9, 2023, our office received your Campaign Treasurer's Report for the covered period of October 21, 2023, through November 2, 2023, that was due in our office on Friday, November 3, 2023.

Late reports are assessed a fine per Florida State Statute 106.07(8)(b):

- (b) Upon determining that a report is late, the filing officer shall immediately notify the candidate or chair of the political committee as to the failure to file a report by the designated due date and that a fine is being assessed for each late day. The fine is \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each special primary election, special election, primary election, and general election, the fine is \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For reports required under s. 106.141(8), the fine is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. Upon receipt of the report, the filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine which is due and shall notify the candidate or chair or registered agent of the political committee. The filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine due based upon the earliest of the following:
 - 1. When the report is actually received by such officer.
 - When the report is postmarked.
 - When the certificate of mailing is dated.
 - 4. When the receipt from an established courier company is dated.
- 5. When the electronic receipt issued pursuant to s. 106.0705 or other electronic filing system authorized in this section is dated.

Such fine shall be paid to the filing officer within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due, unless appeal is made to the Florida Elections Commission pursuant to paragraph (c). Notice is deemed complete upon proof of delivery of written notice to the mailing or street address on record with the filing officer. In the case of a candidate, such fine is not an allowable campaign expenditure and shall be paid only from personal funds of the candidate. An officer or member of a political committee is not personally liable for such fine.

Your report was 5 days late and the assessed fine is \$3,155.05.

Payments must be made payable to the Town of Melbourne Beach from your personal funds and may not be paid from your campaign account. The fine is due within 20 (twenty) days of receipt of this notice, unless an appeal is made to the Florida Elections Commission.

Florida State Statute 106.07(8)(c):

(c) Any candidate or chair of a political committee may appeal or dispute the fine, based upon, but not limited to, unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request and shall be entitled to a hearing before the Florida Elections Commission, which shall have the authority to waive the fine in whole or in part. The Florida Elections Commission must consider the mitigating and aggravating circumstances contained in s. 106.265(3) when determining the amount of a fine, if any, to be waived. Any such request shall be made within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due. In such case, the candidate or chair of the political committee shall, within the 20-day period, notify the filing officer in writing of his or her intention to bring the matter before the commission.

DRAFT MINUTES

The Town Commission conducted a SPECIAL TOWN COMMISSION meeting on Wednesday, June 3, 2020 in the COMMUNITY CENTER to address the items below.

Commission Members:

Mayor Jim Simmons Vice Mayor Wyatt Hoover Commissioner Steve Walters Commissioner Sherrie Quarrie Commissioner Corey Runte

Staff Members:

Town Manager Elizabeth Mascaro Interim Town Clerk Jennifer Torres Town Attorney Clifford Repperger to go to the beach – they will be parking at crossovers and guests can park at Ocean Park.

Commissioner Runte said he's been involved with downtown Melbourne parking issues for years and in Melbourne Beach he feels the solution has to be a comprehensive parking management program. He added that the Town did a parking survey, received resident feedback, and now the Commission needs to implement their wishes.

Commissioner Runte said the expected population growth in Florida is huge and if we don't address parking issues now - it's going to get much worse in 10-15 years.

Mayor Simmons reiterated that his initial response was only based on the fact that he thought some members of the Commission wanted to sell visitor passes and if that isn't the case – his vote stands.



Commissioner Walters said although he is against paid parking, he feels if the Town is going to do it – they need to include Ryckman Park because most people using the pier are not from here.

He went on to say he would rather see no visitor parking passes then to see them open parking at the end of streets. Instead they can pay and park at Ocean Park.

Mayor Simmons stated that if they are not considering non-resident decals – he is onboard.

Town Manager Mascaro asked the Commission to clarify exactly what streets will be impacted.

Mayor Simmons said he would rather workshop it and come up with a total plan.

Commissioner Quarrie said the workshop is about designing the decals – and what kiosk vendor's offer and she feels they need to take a vote now on the specifics of resident and non-resident parking.

Mayor Simons said we also need to decide if we are issuing decals annually or for another term, as well as how many are issued and how they are issued.

Commissioner Runte said all residents should receive a free decal for each car they own.
