I acknowledge the requirement listed below must be implemented in order to protect the storm drain inlets and the Indian River Lagoon from illicit discharge runoff in the Town of Melbourne Beach.

During the resurfacing and reconstruction of pools the following must be complied with:

- 1. All drainage MUST be contained in the yard to prevent flow onto neighboring properties, the street, storm drains, the lagoon or the ocean.
- 2. Barrels MUST be utilized during all stages of drainage, reconstruction and construction of a pool.
- 3. Pursuant to Town of Melbourne Beach Code of Ordinances 27-28, Illicit/illegal discharges. No person and those persons under its control, shall throw, drain, or otherwise discharge, cause, or allow discharge into the municipal storm sewer systems any pollutants or waters containing any pollutants, whether such discharges occur through piping connections, runoff, exfiltration, infiltration, seepage or leaks.
